Time	Outline	Directions
5 min	Introduction <u>KWL Chart</u>	Prior to watching the first video call with the explorer, fill out the KWL Chart with your class. What do your students <b>Know</b> about Antarctica and the Endurance22 expedition? Next, record what your students <b>Want to Know</b> .
20 min	Video Call	Students will be introduced to explorer Tim Jacob and learn more about the expedition by watching his first video call here.
10 min	Post-Call Discussion	After debriefing the video call, students will record what they have <b>Learned</b> about the expedition and the explorer.
15 min	Pack Your Bags (Elementary) Pack Your Bags (Middle School/High School)	Based on the information students have learned about the expedition, students will write about what they think they would need to bring to Antarctica as an explorer.
5 min	Questions for the Explorer!	As an exit ticket, have your students think of additional questions they have for explorers on the expedition team.
